1. What two descriptions of man does Job give in verse 1?
2. What illustrations does Job use to describe the brevity of life? (verses 2 & 11)
 - a. Thought question: What apostle also used the illustration of Job 14:2?
3. What common concept of death is based upon verse 5?
4. In verses 7-12, Job contrasts the death of a human with the death of a tree:
 - a. What is the difference between the two with respect to life after death?
 - b. What type of life is Job discussing here? (physical or spiritual)
 - c. How does verse 14 of this chapter and verses 25-27 of chapter 19 help us determine the answer to the previous (part b) question?
5. Remember that Job saw God as the cause of his calamity. With this in mind, what illustrations did Job use in verses 18 & 19 to describe God's (allegedly) punitive actions against Job?
