- What illustrations does Job use to describe the brevity of life? (verses 2 & 11)
 - a. Thought question: What apostle also used the illustration of Job 14:2?
- 3. What common concept of death is based upon verse 5?
- 4. In verses 7-12, Job contrasts the death of a human with the death of a tree:
 - a. What is the difference between the two with respect to life after death?
 - b. What type of life is Job discussing here? (physical or spiritual)
 - c. How does verse 14 of this chapter and verses 25-27 of chapter 19 help us determine the answer to the previous (part b) question?
- 5. Remember that Job saw God as the cause of his calamity. With this in mind, what illustrations did Job use in verses 18 & 19 to describe God's (allegedly) punitive actions against Job?
