- 5. To what standard of wisdom does Eliphaz appeal in verses 10 & 18?
  - a. Explain his point about Job in verse 10:
- 6. Assuming that the "saints" in verse 15 refers to "angels," what point is Eliphaz making in verses 14-16?
- 7. Of what does Eliphaz accuse Job in verses 13 & 25?
- 8. How does Eliphaz describe the life and fate of the wicked?
