 - c. Also from these verses, what do we know that Job had at some point received from God?
2. Who could Job not find any direction that he looked?
3. What does Job appear to now understand about God's purpose for him? (v. 10)
 - a. However, what was his reasoning about this purpose in verse 14?
4. According to Job, what can man not make God do?
5. Job had been wishing for an audience with God, but what was Job's emotional reaction to the thought of God's presence?
6. What had God's (alleged) treatment of Job done to Job's heart?
