## **Job 39**

- 1. Chapter 38 revealed God's wisdom and power as seen in nature and meteorology. Continuing from verse 39 of chapter 38, this chapter addresses God's wisdom as seen in what?
- 2. What is learned about God's wisdom and providence from the mountain goat? (vs. 1-4)
- 3. List some of the attributes of the wild donkey? (5-8)
- 4. Depending upon your translation, verse 9 references a "unicorn," "wild ox," or even "buffalo" (Darby), or "rhinoceros" (Vulgate). Strong evidence exists for it being a rhinoceros, but regardless:
  - a. What attributes does it possess?
  - b. How do these attributes reflect upon God's purpose and design?
- 5. The animal in verse 13-18 is most likely the ostrich.
  - a. What peculiar attribute is mentioned in regard to its young?
  - b. Why does the ostrich "laugh at" (scorn) the horse and its rider?

- 6. What animal is discussed in 19-25?
  - a. What features and aspects of this animal are discussed by God?
  - b. Special emphasis is placed upon *what particular* use of this animal? (along with this text, you can use Proverbs 21:31)
  - c. What warnings did God later give to the Jews regarding these animals? (Deut. 17:16 & Isaiah 31:1)
- 7. What two predatory fowls are discussed in verses 27-30?
  - a. What aspects of their design are cited by God? (particularly of the later bird)
