- 1. A compelling argument has been made for verses 1-14 of this chapter actually belonging after verse 6 of chapter 42. Considering the subject matter of chapters 39 + 40:15-24 + chap. 41, what plausible argument can be made for this proposed arrangement?
- 2. In verses 1-5, what did God charge Job of doing, and how did Job answer God?
- 3. As in 38:3, what does God again tell Job to do in verse 7?
  - a. What did Paul tell the Corinthians to do in 1 Corinthians 16:13?
- 4. Verses 8-14 lists several divine abilities and attributes. What was God's purpose for stating these?
  - a. What attribute and power is stated in verse 8?
  - b. What attribute and power is stated in verse 9?
  - c. What attributes are stated in verse 10?
  - d. What power is stated in verses 11-13?

- 5. Assuming that Job were to possess all of these powers and attributes, what was God willing then to grant?
- 6. Much has been written and speculated about the identity of the "behemoth." (It is most likely extinct!) Some say it refers to an elephant or hippopotamus. **From the Job text:** 
  - a. What reasons are against it being one of these animals?
