  - a. What in Colossians 1:16?
  
  - b. Hebrews 1:10-12?
  
4. What attributes of Jesus are stated in verses 4-5?
  - a. What is the purpose of "light," and how is this a metaphor of the work of Christ?
  
5. Who was the "man" that was sent by God, and what was his purpose?

6. Who were Christ's "own people?"
7. What is meant by the phrase, "the Word was made flesh"? (14)
8. Since John was older than Jesus (Lk. 1:26), in what sense was Jesus "before" John?
9. In what special sense was Jesus able to "make known" the Father? (v. 18, and see John 14:9)
10. Who had prophesied of John the baptist?
11. John twice calls Jesus "the Lamb of God" in this chapter. What about Jesus does he emphasize by this term?
12. John baptized with water, but Jesus would baptize with the \_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_?
13. Who were the first two disciples to follow Jesus?
14. What other disciple did Jesus find in Bethsaida?
15. What disciple did Philip find?
16. What did Nathanael ask about Nazareth?
17. What is interesting about Jesus' assessment of Nathanael's character?
  - a. What about Nathanael's reaction indicates that this was an example of omniscience on Jesus' part?
