- 3. In view of His statement in verse 11, what did Jesus mean in verse 4 when He said that Lazarus' "sickness was not unto death?"
- 4. What warning did the disciples give Jesus about returning to Judea?
- 5. What euphemism did Jesus use in verse 11 for Lazarus' condition?
 - a. What did the disciples think that He meant?
 - b. Why did Jesus say that He was glad that He was not earlier with Lazarus? (note...Martha later affirmed this in verse 21, and Mary in 32)
- 6. What did Thomas wrongly conclude that Jesus meant?

- 7. After the deliberate travel delay (6) and the travel, how long had Lazarus now been dead, and what was happening to his body?
- 8. When Jesus spoke of the resurrection of Lazarus, what did Martha conclude was going to happen?
 - a. What did Jesus actually intend to do?
 - b. What claim did Jesus make about Himself in verse 25?
- 9. How did Jesus react to seeing Lazarus?
- 10. What command did Jesus give Lazarus, and what happened?
 - a. Later, according to John 12:10-11, what did the chief priests plan to do to Lazarus, and why?
- 11. After Jesus raised Lazarus, what two concerns did the Jewish Council have? (48)
 - a. What solution did Caiaphas offer?
 - b. What plans were then made for Jesus? (see vs. 53 and 57 for help)
 - c. How did Jesus change His travel plans after this?
- 12. At what event did the Jews look particularly for Jesus?
 - a. What did the surmise about Jesus regarding that event? (56)
