  - a. From this group of people, who did Jesus "lose?"
  - b. **Note:** What other group of disciples does Jesus mention in verse 20?
- 6. What did Jesus "give" the apostles, and how did the world react towards them as a result?
- 7. Jesus prayed for His disciples to be "one" (unified).
  - a. Which disciples in verse 11?
  - b. Which disciples in verse 21?
