  - a. Verses 4 and 5 seem to indicate that Pilate had two reasons for this treatment of Jesus: What were they?
  - b. What additional reason does Luke give (Luke 23:16) for Pilate chastising Jesus?
  - c. What made Pilate even "more afraid" of his involvement in Jesus' trial?
- 2. Who had "the greater sin" in crucifying Jesus? Why?
- 3. How do we harmonize verse 17 with Luke 23:26?
- 4. From other Gospel accounts, what do we know about the two "others" between whom Jesus was crucified?
- 5. What controversy was had concerning the inscription that Pilate affixed to the cross?
  - a. What irony existed in regard to Pilate's wording?

## Questions On The Gospel of John

- 6. Per Roman custom, the executioners divided Jesus' garments among themselves as a type of reward. But in fulfillment of Psalm 22:18, what interesting thing did the soldiers do with Jesus' tunic?
  - a. Who typically wore a tunic like the one that Jesus wore? (Ex. 39:22 for help)
- 7. To whom did Jesus commit the care of His mother?
- 8. Why didn't the soldiers break the legs of Jesus, and what spiritually symbolic and significant thing did they do instead?
  - a. Why did the Jews want the bodies of Jesus and the thieves taken down from the cross on that same day?
  - b. What two reasons have traditionally been offered as to why the legs of crucifixion victims were broken?
- 9. Who claimed the body of Jesus, and what two earlier interactions did he have with, and concerning Jesus?
- 10. Where was Jesus buried?
- 11. *Thought question -* Was there any significance in the tomb being "new" (Matt. 27:60)?
