 - e. What interesting observation is made about the linen clothes and the handkerchief?
- 4. What was Mary doing while she stood outside of the tomb and then while she looked into the tomb?
- 5. Who did Mary then see **in** the tomb? What additional description of them is given by Matthew (28:3)?
- 6. Who did Mary see when she turned around?
 - a. Who did she initially suppose him to be?
- 7. Thought Question: Where did Jesus get His clothes?

- 8. With whom did Jesus meet later that same day?
 - a. Who was notably absent from that assembly?
 - b. What did that doubting disciple demand to see as a condition of belief?
 - c. How did he respond when he did see this evidence, and what is particularly notable about his response?
