2. Who first recognized Jesus, and what had just happened that likely caused him to conclude that the man on the beach was Jesus?
3. What observation was made about the fish net after the disciples caught 153 large fish?
4. What did Jesus already have on the charcoals when the disciples arrived on the shore?
 - a. What did Jesus add to this food?
5. What question did Jesus three times ask Peter?
 - a. *Thought Question* — Was the question actually the same each time?
 - b. *Thought Question* — What linguistic nuance affects the meaning of the question?

6. What did Jesus three times tell Peter to do?
 - a. What did Jesus intend for Peter to do?

7. What did Jesus predict regarding the nature of Peter's death?

8. How did Jesus answer Peter's question about John (the disciple whom Jesus loved)?
 - a. What misconception later developed from the Lord's answer to Peter about John?

 - b. *Thought Question* — What lesson can be learned from verses 22 and 23 about how misconceptions develop?

9. What observation did John make about Jesus' many works and the gospel record?
