 - a. What would Jerusalem later become?
 - b. What special facility would be built there?
- 2. What proposal did Adoni-zedek make to the other Amorite kings?
 - a. What had the Gibeonites done that caused this proposal to be made?
- 3. Though we read about the Gibeonites back in chapter 9, how is Gibeon city described in this chapter?
- 4. After the threat from the 5 Amorite kings, what did the Gibeonites ask of Joshua?
 - a. What did Joshua do?
- 5. According to verses 9, 15 and 43, what remained the home operating base of the Israelis?
- 6. According to verses 10-14, in what ways did God miraculously intervene on behalf of Israel?

- a. *Thought question:* Though, as we regularly observe, miracles are not to be explained, but to be believed, from what we do know about time and the universe, what must have happened in the long-day miracle?
- 7. To where did the 5 Amorite kings flee?
 - a. What was initially done to these Amorite kings?
 - b. What was eventually done to them?
 - c. What symbolic thing did Joshua tell the military chiefs to do to the kings, and what did their actions signify?
- 8. Verses 28 and following of this chapter use similar language to describe Joshua's conquests of Makkedah, Libnah, Lachish, Eglon, Hebron, Debir, the hill country to the negeb, Kadesh-barnea to Gaza, Goshen to Gibeon and "the whole country." What was done in each case?
- 9. According to verse 42, how was Israel able to accomplish such amazing military victories over such long established nations?
