- 1. What king organized a great collection of other kings and armies against Joshua and Israel?
  - a. How are they described in verse 4?
  - b. Also in v. 4, what military equipment and assets did they have?
  - c. Where did this great battle occur?
  - d. How did the battle go?
  - e. What remark is made later, in verse 20, as to why this outcome occurred?
  - f. As instructed by God, what did Joshua do to the horses & chariots?
  - g. *Thought question:* Horses are strong and fast animals. From the standpoint of mere imagery, what might have been the significance of hamstringing them?
- 2. From verse 10, what was the relationship of Hazor to the other places represented in this alliance?

- 3. What did Joshua do to Hazor that he did not do to the other cities (at least those built upon "mounds")?
  - a. As described in chapters 13 and following, what was done with the Canaanite cities?
- 4. How is Joshua commended in verse 15?
- 5. From the remark about the Gibeonites in verse 19, what do we know about Israelite treaties?
- 6. What do we learn about the Anakim?

a. Who (what) were they?

- 7. At first glance, verses 21 23 seem to indicate that Philistine cities were captured at this time, but what do we later learn from chapter 13:1-6?
  - a. How do we harmonize these passages? (for help, see the last sentence of Joshua 11)
