- 2. What lands and peoples had not yet been conquered at this time? (verses 1-6 + verse 13)
- 3. What did God say would be done about these people? (6)
 - a. From this same verse, what do we learn that Joshua was to do with the lands that were conquered?
- 4. How many tribes were left to settle?
 - a. Why did only one half of the Manasseh tribe remain?
- 5. According to verses 14 and 33, what did the Levities NOT receive for inheritance, and what DID they receive?
- 6. About the last half of this chapter is devoted to land and city allotments where? (a general answer is fine, see verse 32)
 - a. Who made these allotments?
 - b. Verse 31 is helpful in understanding the division of the Manasseh tribe (the other half is addressed in Joshua 17). Which family branch settled on the EAST side of Jordan?
