- 1. What observation is made in this chapter about Joshua's age?
- 2. Who did Joshua call together, and for what general purpose? (I will address specifics in later questions.)
- 3. Of what things does Joshua remind these men that God had done for the Jewish people? (vs. 3-4, 9)
  - a. How does verse 9 elaborate on verse 3 with regard to the "nations?"
- 4. What would God continue to do for the Jewish people? (v. 5)
  - a. Upon what conditions would God continue to bless and help the Jews? (see 6, 8, 11)
- 5. According to verses 7, 12 and 16, what things were the Jews NOT to do?
  - a. And what would they lose by doing these things?

- 6. According to verses 12 and 13, what would be the consequences if the Jews allowed the Canaanites to remain in their new land?
- 7. What did Joshua mean when he said that he was "going the way of all the earth?"
- 8. What did Joshua say about God's land promise? (v. 14)
- 9. What observation is made about God's timing in responding to future Jewish disobedience and rebellion?
