

## Joshua 24

1. Where did Joshua meet the Jewish tribes for his final address to them?
  - a. What had Abraham done at this place? (Genesis 12:6)
  - b. What had Jacob's people done there? (Genesis 35:4)
  - c. What had Jacob purchased there? (Genesis 33:18-19 and Joshua 24:32)
  
2. What "river" is referred to in verses 2, 3, 14 and 15?
  - a. What three places (areas) are cited as sources of idolatry that had affected the Hebrew people? (14 & 15)
  
3. This chapter contains several important historical facts:
  - a. What was the religious background of Abraham and his family?
  - b. God gave mount Seir to Esau and his descendants, but Jacob and his family went down to \_\_\_\_\_.
  - c. The Jews stayed at this place "a long time." How long was it?
  - d. What manifestations of God's power did the Jews see in Egypt and afterwards? (some are mentioned here, but list as many as you like)

- e. How many nations had occupied Canaan?
  - f. Who was Balaam, and how did God use him?
  - g. What did God “send” to expel some of the Canaanites?
4. Following this history lesson, what did Joshua urge the Jews to do?
  5. In what sense or connection did Joshua tell the people that they could NOT serve the Lord? (19-20)
  6. What did Joshua tell the people to put away?
  7. Where did Joshua put the words that he wrote?
  8. What object served as a “witness” to their agreement, and where was this item placed?
  9. How old was Joshua when he died?
  10. What timeframe is stated as to how long Israel continued to serve God?
  11. What observation is made about Joseph’s “bones?”
  12. What other important person’s death is recorded in this chapter?
