 - a. To whom was it to be done?
 - b. Why did it have to be done at that time?
 - c. When was circumcision to be done according to the original law of Genesis 17:10-12?
- 3. Two names are given for the place where the circumcisions occurred:
 - a. What name is first mention? (*Optional...* Answer this question only if your Bible has a marginal note or if you have easy access to some other source: *What did this name mean*?)
 - b. God renamed the place "Gilgal." What was significant about naming the place "Gilgal?"

- 4. What did the people do after the males had healed from their circumcisions?
- 5. From this chapter, what do we learn about the manna?
- 6. Who did Joshua see while standing by Jericho?
 - a. What did Joshua want to know about his intentions?
 - b. How did the "man" identify himself?
 - c. How might Jude 9 help to identify this person?
 - d. What did he have in his hand, and what other prior incidence does the Bible mention of this? (see Numbers 22:23 for help)
 - e. What did the angel tell Joshua to do? Why?
 - f. Who else had been told to do the same thing? (see Ex. 3:5 for help)
