3. What did Israel again do? (6)
 - a. What all “gods” did they serve?

4. Into whose hands did God deliver Israel this time?

5. According to verses 8 & 9, how widespread was the oppression this time?
 - a. What did the Israelites then do?

6. Verses 11-14 reveal an attitude change in God and a different approach in saving Israel. Of what did He remind them in verses 11-12?
 - a. What did God refuse to do this time? (13)

- b. With a hint of sarcasm, to whom did God tell Israel to turn for deliverance? (14)

- 7. In addition to merely “crying out” to God for help, what did the Jews do this time? (15-16)
 - a. What fruits were manifested in this action?

 - b. How was God affected by their attitude and actions?

- 8. In verse 18, the leaders of Gilead asked “who would deliver them?” Glancing ahead to chapter 11 for you answer, who was chosen to deliver the Israelites from the Philistines and Ammonites?
