- 4) Why did God speak to Moses, rather than tell the people directly? (*for help, see Ex. 20:19*)
- 5) What latitude is shown with regard to the type of animal that was offered as a burnt offering?
 - a) List these three option categories:
 - b) Under these three categories, list the specific kinds of animals that were authorized for use as a burnt offering:
 - c) What general economic reality does this option accommodate?
 - d) How do 2 Corinthians 8:12 & 1 Cor. 16:2 relate to this principle under current divine Law?
- 6) What was to be done with the animal's blood? Who was to do it?
- 7) What was to be done with the individual animal pieces? By whom?
- 8) What would be God's reaction to the sacrifice?
