  - b) Comparing Romans 5:1 and Ephesians 2:15, explain the two types of peace that are produced by Christ:

- 3) Different from the sacrifices of chapter 1, what change is allowed in these sacrifices with respect to *gender*?
  - a) What characteristic of the sacrifices remained the same as it was for the burnt offerings of chapter 1?
  - b) What *kind of animal (creature)* could be used for a burnt offering that is **not** allowed here?
- 4) What was the purpose of the offerer laying his hands on the head of the sacrifice?
- 5) What two things are prohibited from being eaten?
- 6) Where were peace/fellowship offerings to be *killed*?
- 7) What two purposes were served by peace offerings?
- 8) What was to be done with their blood?
