- 2) What 4 classifications of people or offices are listed in this chapter as being capable of committing this type of sin? (*for help: verses 3, 13, 22, 27*)
- 3) Many efforts have been made by various religious people to excuse unintentional sins. What does this chapter teach about unintentional sins as regarding guilt and innocence?
- 4) At what point was the sinner of this chapter able to bring his offering to the Lord? (*see verse 23 for help*)
- 5) The type of animal to be used for these sin offerings differs in some cases. List the animal that was to be used for:
  - a) The Priest: \_\_\_\_\_
  - b) The Community: \_\_\_\_\_
  - c) The Leader: \_\_\_\_\_
  - d) The Individual: \_\_\_\_\_ OR \_\_\_\_\_
- 6) With sins of the leader and the individual, a change occurs with regard to which altar's horns were to be smeared with the animal's blood:
  - a) Which altar's horns were to be smeared with blood for the sins of *priests* and the *whole community*?
  - b) Which altar's horns were to be smeared with blood for the sins of *leaders* and *individuals*?
- 7) With the offerings for all four classes of people, where was blood to be *poured*?
- 8) Where were the bull's carcasses taken, and what was done with them?
