

## Leviticus 5

- 1) The significance of this chapter is set forth in verse 17: What sin principle is there stated?
- 2) What responsibility is placed upon the witness of verse 1? (*Note: the King James Version is vague on this verse. Consult a different version if possible.*)
- 3) How could a person become “unclean?”
  - a) What was the spiritual consequence *if he knew* that he was unclean?
  - b) What was the spiritual consequence *if he did not* know that he was unclean?
- 4) For the sins described in verses 1-5, what sacrifice was to be made:
  - a) First sacrifice option? (if able to give it)
  - b) Second sacrifice option? (if unable to give the first)
  - c) Third sacrifice option? (if unable to give either of the first two)
  - d) What two types of offering were to be made for these sins? (*v. 7*)
  - e) To whom were these sacrifices to be brought? (*vs. 7 & 8*)
  - f) What would be accomplished for the sinner by these offerings? (*v. 13*)
- 5) What type of sin is addressed in verses 15 & 16?
  - a) How is the *type* of sacrifice different from the earlier ones?
  - b) What was to be added to the sacrifice?
