## Leviticus 9

- 2) Leviticus 9:5 states that "the whole congregation" was to "come near" before the Lord's presence. From verse 1, what might be suggested about the identity of this "congregation?"
- 3) List the sacrifices that were to be offered:

- 6) Who is twice mentioned as being the ones who presented the sacrifice blood to Aaron?
- 7) What earlier teaching regarding the design of the Altar is supported in verse 22 by the fact that Aaron "stepped down" from the Altar?
- 8) How did God show His approval of the sacrifice?
