- 1) What is this chapter about?
 - a) What does this chapter have *particularly* in common with the next chapter?
 - b) What does this chapter have *generally* in common with chapters 11, 12, 14 and 15?
- 2) Who was charged with inspecting skin conditions such as swelling, spots and eruptions?
- 3) How many days was a person to be “shut up” for inspection?
- 4) What was a person to do if his skin condition was found *not* to be leprous? (v. 6)
- 5) What were the symptoms of *chronic* leprosy? (hint: 10, 11)
- 6) What factual statement is made about “raw flesh?”
- 7) What was the fate of a person who was diagnosed with persistent leprosy?
 - a) What was he to do with his appearance?
 - b) What was he to announce?
 - c) Where was he to live?
- 8) Change in hair color was one of the ways of determining the seriousness of a skin condition: What different colors are mentioned?
- 9) What was to be done with garments that were contaminated by leprosy?
