- 1) What type of uncleanness is addressed in this chapter?
 - a) 5 particular types of this uncleanness are addressed. What are they?
- 2) Concerning the discharge of verses 2-15 (possibly Gonorrhea):
 - a) What all became unclean from the discharge?
 - b) What all was to be washed?
 - c) How many days were required for cleansing?
 - d) What was to be offered on the 8th day?
- 3) Verses 16, 17 describe a seminal emission. What was a man to do in order to be clean?
- 4) Verse 18 describes seminal emission in copulation, with the same cleansing requirements as previous. How do these instructions harmonize with Exodus 19:15?
- 5) Verses 19-24 address normal female menstruation. What was to be done for cleansing?
- 6) Verse 24 describes the possibility of accidental contamination of a woman's husband. What do Leviticus 18:19 and 20:18 teach about *deliberate* sexual relations during a woman's period?
- 7) Verses 25-30 describe a more protracted issue of blood from a woman (possibly excessive menstruation). How did this condition affect the woman of Mark 5:25-27?
