 - b) How had the sinful behavior of its inhabitants affected the land?
- 6) The term "uncover nakedness" is used euphemistically in this chapter and elsewhere: What is the actual meaning of the phrase?
- 7) Using *general* descriptions, what categories of sexual immorality are addressed in this chapter?
- 8) What prohibition is made regarding treatment of "children?" Did any Jews ever practice such a thing?
