- 1) Some of this chapter's sins were discussed back in Lev. 18: What is attached to the crimes in this chapter?
- 2) What is the difference between "statutes" (or ordinances) and "judgments?"
- 3) Who or what was "Molech," and what crime was committed with respect to him/it?
  - a) What was the punishment for committing this crime?
- 4) What sin is discussed in verses 4-5?
  - a) What was the punishment for this sin?
  - b) How does Matthew 12:30 relate to this practice?
  - c) How does 2 John 10-11 relate to it?
- 5) What were "familiar spirits" and wizards?
  - a) What punishment was given for this crime?
- 6) What was the punishment for cursing father or mother?
- 7) What is meant by the phrase "uncover nakedness?"
- 8) Mention is repeatedly made of one "uncovering the nakedness" of a father or uncle by having illicit relations with his spouse: Why is this connection made? (*hint: Gen. 2:24*)

- 9) Some brethren argue that “adultery” is “non-sexual covenant-breaking:”  
How does Lev. 18:20 help to explain the “adultery” of Lev. 20:10?
- 10) What marital arrangement was punishable by *burning*?
- 11) Where earlier in Scripture do we see homosexuality condemned?  
What New Testament Scriptures condemn homosexuality?
- 12) Who/what all was to die in cases of bestiality?
- 13) What sexual arrangement resulted in *childlessness*?
- 14) Who had committed the abominations described in this chapter?
- 15) How does Genesis 15:16 connect to Lev. 20:22, 23?
  - a) What had become “full?”
- 16) As in chap. 18, how is “land” personified in this chapter?
- 17) Along with personal moral laws, what other laws were the Jews reminded to follow?
