

Leviticus 21

- 1) What office(s) does this chapter address?
 - a) Those addressed in this chapter occupy 3 categories:
 - i) What is the general category (vs. 16-24)?
 - ii) Who is discussed in verses 1-9?
 - iii) Who is discussed in verses 10-15?
- 2) What exceptions were made for the priests with respect to mourning the dead (and so becoming “defiled” by touching a dead body)?
 - a) Verses 10-12 address this subject again, but with a seeming contradiction. There is no actual contradiction. Explain why: (*note: pay careful attention to the difference between verses 10 and 11*)
- 3) What rules were made with respect to the priest’s hair and beard?
- 4) What rules were made regarding:
 - a) Who *common* priests were *not* to marry?
 - b) Who *common* priests *were* to marry?
 - c) Who *high* priests were *not* to marry?
 - d) Who *high* priests *were* to marry?
- 5) What was the punishment for a priest’s daughter who was a prostitute?
- 6) What physical conditions prohibited men from serving as priests?
