- 1) This chapter deals with various aspects of sacrifices:
  - a) Who was allowed to eat of the holy things?
    - i) When were members of this group *not* allowed to eat of the holy things?
  - b) Who was not allowed to eat of the holy things?
  - c) What law was made regarding the *quality* of the sacrifices?
  - d) What law was made regarding the minimum age of the sacrifice?
  - e) When were sacrifices of thanksgiving permitted to be eaten?
- 2) List some things that could cause a priest or his family member to be unclean:
  - a) What did the unclean person have to do to be again authorized to eat of the holy food?
- 3) Answer "yes" or "no" as to who was authorized to eat of the holy food:
  - a) Priest's daughter who married a non-priest?
  - b) Priest's daughter who was widowed and childless?
  - c) Sojourners?
  - d) Priest's purchased or owned servants?
  - e) Hired servants?
- 4) What conditions disqualified an animal from being used as a sacrifice?
  - a) What (minor) prophet rebuked people for using blemished animals as sacrifices?
