1. There were originally 12 apostles. What two men were later added to this list? (*for help see Acts 1:26 and Galatians 1:1*)
 - a. Peter is also called Simon in Matthew 10:2, but what else is he called in John 1:42?
 - b. What did Jesus call James and John in Mark 3:17?
 - c. What happened to (John's brother) James according to Acts 12:2?
 - d. For what "doubt" was Thomas known? (John 20:25)
 - e. What was Matthew's occupation? (v. 3)
 - f. Simon is here called the "Canaanite," but what is he called in Luke 6:15?
 - g. By what notable deed was Judas known? (v. 4)
2. Why do we call the commission of Matthew 10:5-6 the *limited commission*? (*To whom were the apostles to "go" and not go?*)
 - a. How is the apostolic commission of Matthew 28:19 different?
 - b. According to Matthew 10:7-8, what were the apostles to do?
 - c. According to verses 9-10, who was to support them in their work?

- d. What was their housing policy according to verses 11-13?
 - e. What were they to do regarding people who rejected them?
 - f. How bad would the consequences be for such rejecters? (v. 15)
3. What is the significance of the 4 creatures mentioned in verse 16?
 4. Why were the apostles to “beware of men?”
 - a. According to verse 21, this betrayal might come from who?
 5. How are verses 19 and 20 often misused and misapplied today?
 6. He who endures to the _____ shall be saved. (22)
 7. What are we to fear more than physical harm to our bodies? (28)
 8. What is necessary for salvation according to verses 32 & 33?
 9. According to verse 34, what did Jesus *bring* and *not bring* to the earth?
 10. What relationships can be affected by people rejecting God’s truth? (21, 35)
 11. Who is not worthy of Christ? (v. 37)
 12. Those who receive the apostles also receive Who? (v. 40)
