

## Questions On Matthew Chapter 26

1. What were the chief priests, scribes, elders and high priest planning to do to Jesus after the feast?
  - a. Why didn't they do it *during* the feast? (5)
  
2. Matthew 26:6-13 tells the story of the woman anointing Jesus. At whose house was Jesus at this time?
  - a. According to John's account (John 12:2-3), who else was at this anointing?
  - b. Matthew and Mark do not name the woman who anointed Jesus, but according to John's account (John 12:3), who anointed Jesus?
  - c. Matthew states that the oil was "costly," but what type of oil did Mark and John say that it was? (Mark 14:3 or John 12:3)
  - d. What objection was raised by some of the disciples? (vs. 8-9)
  - e. John's account singles out *who* as the leading objector? (Jn. 12:4)
  - f. How would Mary be memorialized for her actions? (13)
  
3. What deal did Judas Iscariot make with the chief priests?
  
4. What memorial was being celebrated by Jesus and the apostles when Jesus instituted the Lord's Supper? (vs. 17, 19)
  
5. What discussion arose during the Passover observance (20-25)

- a. According to verse 25, what did Judas now know that Jesus knew concerning his plans?
6. What is the purpose of the Lord's Supper? (26-28; 1 Cor. 11:27-29)
    - a. When would Jesus again commune with disciples in the observance of the Lord's Supper? (29)
  7. What did Jesus predict that Peter would do and how did Peter react to this prediction? (vs. 31-35). What did Peter eventually do? (vs. 69-75)
  8. Verses 36-46 record Christ's garden prayer. Some people cite His words "let this cup pass from me" as evidence that Jesus sought to turn from His mission. However, what was prophesied about Jesus and His mission in Isaiah 42:4?
    - a. What did Jesus say in John 12:27?
    - b. The expression "pass" is also used in the sense of *passing in completion* (see verse 1 of this very chapter, "it came to pass") So, for what did Jesus really pray?
  9. How did Judas identify Jesus to the arresters?
  10. Verse 51 says that one disciple cut off a servant's ear. What additional information does John 18:10 give about this incident?
  11. What did Jesus say that He could do if He had desired to establish His kingdom with physical force? (v. 53)
  12. Before whom did Jesus appear in the first phase of His trial? (57)
