Questions On Matthew Chapter 4

- 1. What occasion in Jesus' life is recorded in Matthew 4:1-11?
 - A. There has been a centuries-old controversy over the temptation of Christ. Many people think of "lust" when they read or hear the word "tempt." What is the difference between these two words?



- B. The Greek word translated "tempt" is also used in Acts 9:26. What did Paul "try" or "attempt" or "assay" to do with regard to the Jerusalem church?
- C. Matthew 4:1 says that the Spirit "led" Jesus into the wilderness to be "tempted" by the devil. However, according to James 1:13, in what way does God NOT tempt men? What does this tell us about why Jesus was tempted?
- D. What did God say in Isaiah's prophecy (Isa. 42:4) that Jesus would not do?
- E. Some people cite the "all points" language of Hebrews 4:15 to argue that Jesus "desired" to do the things that He was tempted to do. Some have even argued that this would include any sin even including homosexuality and pedophilia. However, what did the Hebrew writer actually mean by "all points?" (for help, see the context of Matthew 4:1-10)
- F. What is the devil called in Matthew 4:3 and 1 Thessalonians 3:5? (note that he is not called the "lust inciter." It should be noted that the devil does not have the power to make us lust.)
- G. According to James 4:7, what will the devil do when we resist him?
- H. In Matthew 4:4, 7, 10, what technique did Jesus use to resist and even rebuke the devil?

- I. Matthew 4:11 says that the devil departed from Jesus, but did that mean forever? (see Luke 4:13)
- What did Jesus do when He heard that John had been cast into prison (where did He go? what was His message?)



- A. What prophecy did this fulfill?
- 3. What two brothers did Jesus meet at the sea of Galilee and what did He ask them to do? (18-20)
- 4. What other two brothers did He meet and what did He ask them to do? (21,22)
 - A. Who did these men have to leave in order to follow Jesus?
- 5. What did Jesus preach throughout Galilee? (23)
 - A. What miracles did Jesus perform?
 - B. What was the purpose of miracles? (Mark 16:20; Hebrews 2:4)
