- 1. What do we learn from verse 1 about Jesus' popularity following the sermon on the mount? How does this change by the end of the chapter?
- 2. Who approached Jesus when He came down from the mountain?
  - 1. What did the man do to Jesus?

2. What did the man ask of Jesus?

Matthew 8:1-4 is also recorded in Mark 1:40-45 and Luke 5:12-16

- 3. According to to Luke 5:12, how extensive was his condition?
- 3. Concerning Jesus being worshipped, there are many instances of Jesus being worshipped and accepting the worship (Matthew 2:11; 8:2; 9:18; 14:33; 15:25; 28:9, 17; Mk. 5:6; John 9:38). However, how did Peter react when Cornelius attempted to worship him? (Acts 10:25-26)
  - a. How did Paul and Barnabas react when the people of Lystra attempted to worship them? (Acts 14:13-15)
  - b. How did even an angel react when John attempted to worship him? (Revelation 19:10)
- 4. How quickly did the leper's leprosy disappear after the healing? How does differ from modern claims of miraculous healing? (Matt. 8:3)
- 5. What faith *quality* is commended by Jesus in the story of the healing of the Centurion's servant? (Matthew 8:5-13, *also Lk. 7:1-10 Hint: It is*

- a. What does Colossians 3:17 tell us to do?
- 6. Catholics claim that Peter was the first pope and that a pope cannot be married. However, what did Peter have according to Matthew 8:14 (and 1 Cor. 9:5)?
- Matthew 8:16-17 also in Mark 1:32-34 and Luke 4:40-41
- 7. Quoting from Isaiah 53:4, Matthew said that Jesus "bore" sicknesses when He cured them. Calvinists (and some brethren) cite Isaiah 53:12 to argue that Jesus "bore" our sins by taking them upon Himself. However, the word "bore" is translated from the same Hebrew word in both verses 4 and 12 of Isaiah 53. How does Matthew 8:16-17 help us to define what Jesus did with our sins? (that is, did Jesus "bear" sickness and disease by becoming sick and diseased Himself?)
- 8. What lesson did Jesus want disciples to learn in verses 18-22?
- 9. Matthew 8 describes Jesus' power over what 3 areas:
