

Questions On Micah 2

1. Some sins are committed spontaneously, but what did Micah say about the sins of the people of his day? (v. 1)
 - a. What is said in verse one about *why* they committed these sins?
 - b. Is “might” always “right?”
2. What things did they covet and confiscate?
3. In contrasting what God would do with what the people were doing, verse 3 plays on what word from verse 1?
4. The contrast is again set in verses 2 & 4. Since sinners had wrongly taken property from their neighbors, what would God do to them?
5. What did the sinners tell the prophets?
 - a. What was Amos told not to do? (Amos 7:12, 13, 16)
6. In what *name* did these Jews take pride? (7) How were they wrong in their claim?
7. What strange role had Israel assumed according to verse 8?
8. According to verse 11, what type of prophet was considered the “right” one for that people?
9. What change of outlook occurs in verses 12-13?
