  - c) What had happened to Onesimus at Rome?
- 3) What was Philemon's house sometimes used for?
- 4) Along with the service alluded to in question 3, what other service did Philemon provide for the saints?
- 5) Some people criticize the Bible for condoning slavery. However, Bible laws actually help to protect slaves. Read Exodus 21:1-11, 20, 26-27 and be prepared to explain the difference between treatment of slaves under the Law, and treatment of slaves without God's law:
  - a) What scenarios are described in 1 Timothy 6:1-2?
  - b) How does this passage relate to Philemon and Onesimus?

- 10) How did Paul want Philemon to treat Onesimus when he returned?
- 11)Onesimus departed from Philemon as a mere slave, but would be returning to him also as a \_\_\_\_\_?
- 12) What did Paul offer to do in the event that Onesimus owed Philemon anything?
  - a) In an interesting twist, of what does Paul remind Philemon with respect to Philemon's own debt to Paul? (19)
- 13) In what did Paul have confidence with respect to Philemon?
- 14) What did Paul expect Philemon to do for him in his travels?
