 - a. Verse 7 also speaks of one making himself poor, yet being rich. Who was instructed how to do this in Matthew 19:16-22 and how was he to do it?
6. What is the difference between wealth gained by dishonesty versus wealth gained by labor? (11)
7. What makes the heart sick? (12)
8. What comes to those who disdain or refuse correction (discipline)? (18)
9. What is sweet to the soul? (19)
10. What happens for those who walk with wise men? What happens to the companions of fools? (Verse 20)
