

## Proverbs Chapter 2

1. According to verses 1-4, what things must one do in order to acquire wisdom and knowledge?
2. The Lord gives wisdom to people, but *how* does He give it? (verse 6)
3. What does God's wisdom do for His saints? (v. 8)
4. The righteous delight in the knowledge of God (v. 10), but in what do the wicked delight? (v. 14)
5. What are the characteristics of the wicked according to verses 12-15?
6. Solomon often warned of the dangers of seductive women (2:16-19 5:3; 6:24; 7:5; 22:14; 23:27. What type of speech does this woman use to get her way? (2:16 — *same in 5:3; 6:24; 7:5...*)
  - a. Verse 17 speaks to what two aspects of the marriage relationship?
  - b. What terminology did Jesus use in Matthew 19:4-6 to describe these same two aspects of marriage?
  - c. What are the consequences of giving in to the seductress? (18-19)
7. The rewards and punishments of verses 20-22 are like those stated by Solomon's father (David) in Psalm 37:3, 9, 11, 22, 29. The wicked would be \_\_\_\_\_ from the land, whereas the righteous would \_\_\_\_\_ the land.
