1. What is better than great riches? (v. 1)
2. What do the rich and the poor have in common? (2)
3. What old adage about fools and wise people fits with verse 3?
4. According to verse 6, for how long does childhood training typically impact a person?
5. Verse 8 speaks of sowing and reaping. What does Paul say about this in Galatians 6:8?
6. 19:17 stated that one “lends to the Lord” by helping the poor. What will be the reward according to 22:9?
7. Who must leave in order for contention and strife to cease? (10)
8. According to verse 13, what does the lazy man do (say) in order to avoid work?
9. Verse 14 again warns of the mouth of the immoral woman. What did we see earlier about how she uses her words to attract the unsuspecting? (see 6:24 and 7:21)
10. Verse 6 spoke of “training” children. What is included in this according to verse 15?

11. Verses 16 and 22 speak of mistreating and robbing the poor? What about the poor necessitates this warning?
12. What reasons does Solomon give in verses 18, 19 and 21 for why one should hold on to the wise words of the Lord?
13. Of what things did Solomon write? (20)
14. Why should one NOT associate with an angry / furious man? (24-25)
15. How much might one potentially lose by becoming a surety for another's debt? (26-27)
16. Verse 28 (and verse 10 of the next chapter) warn against moving what?
  - a. What *spiritual* principle is contained in this warning?
17. According to verses 11 and 29, who will be honored by kings?
