- 2. Why should one not "weary" himself about acquiring wealth? (vs. 4-5)
 - **a.** Jesus warned against obsessing over material things (Matt. 6:24-32). What things did He tell us that we should seek? (v. 33)
- **3.** Proverbs 23:7 is a popular verse. What does it teach about words and intentions?
- **4.** Why not speak to be heard by a fool? (9)
- **5.** Who is the Redeemer of the fatherless? (10-11)
- **6.** Child discipline is difficult and painful to consistently practice (Hebrews 12:11), but what is ultimately accomplished by it? (13-14)
- 7. A parent / teacher rejoices when a child / student receives instruction, but when does the parent or teacher rejoice even more? (15-16) (*That is, they rejoice when the child is able to do what?*)
- **8.** 1:15 warned against associating with violent people. 20:19 warned against associating with flatterers. 22:24 warned against associating with angry people. With whom are we to avoid associating according to verses 20-21 of this chapter?
