

Proverbs Chapter 3

1. Solomon warns against forgetting God's instructions. Peter spoke of the importance of being reminded of essential truths (2 Pet. 1:12, 15; 3:1-2.) Why is this important according to 2 Peter 1:10-12?
2. What blessings would come from following God's instructions? (verses 2, 4, 8, 23, 24)
 - a. We must remember that the Jews were under a theocratic form of government which made their blessings *physical* as well as spiritual (Ex. 20:12; Deut. 28). However, what *principle* still applies with regard to wise actions and peace and longevity of life?
3. According to verses 3 & 22, love, faithfulness, wisdom and discretion are compared to the wearing of what type of object?
4. Verses 5-7 describe what is involved in *trusting in the Lord*. According to these verses, what things are we *to do* and *not do* in order for it to constitute *trusting in God*?
5. Verses 9 and 10 speak of the blessings of generous giving. What analogy does Paul use in 2 Cor. 9:6 to make this point?
6. Verses 11-12 make a connection between what *attitude* and what *action*? Who cited this connection in Revelation 3:19?
7. According to verses 13-15, how does one find true wealth?
8. What must I not withhold from my neighbor? (27-28)
9. We must sometimes contend with others (25:9), but when must we not? (v.30)
10. Solomon warned against envying wicked people (3:31; 23:17; 24:1, 19). Why would someone envy a wicked person?
