

Questions on Proverbs Chapter 5

1. Wise lips guard knowledge, v.2. Under the Law of Moses whose special job was it to guard knowledge? (Mal. 2:7) Whose job is it today? (Jude 3)
2. Proverbs frequently warns against adultery and the seductive ways of an adulteress (2:16-19; 6:24-35; 7:5-27 and most of this chapter). What characteristic of the forbidden woman is mentioned in Proverbs 5:3?
 - a. The forbidden woman seems sweet in the beginning but in the end she is _____ (v. 4)
3. Consistent with the advice of Proverbs 1:10, 15, the young man was to avoid what according to 5:8?
4. Committing adultery results in the loss of what things? (9-10)
5. Committing adultery results in *what feeling* at “the end of life? (11)
6. Rather than seeking sexual satisfaction from the spouse of another, verses 15-20 instruct the young man to seek sexual satisfaction where? (see esp. verse 18)
 - a. What does 1 Corinthians 7:2 teach?
 - b. What does Hebrews 13:4 teach?
 - c. Marital sex does serve the purpose of procreation (Genesis 1:28). However, what other purpose does it serve according to Proverbs 5:15-19?
7. What important reminder is given in verse 21 and in Proverbs 15:3? What does Hebrews 4:13 teach?
8. What illustration is used in verse 22 of how sin captures a person?
