- 1. What was John to measure with the measuring rod?
- 2. What was he NOT to measure? Why not?
 - a. What had Jesus before predicted would happen to Jerusalem? (Luke 21:20)
- 3. Using the Bible definition, what was "the holy city?" (for help see Nehemiah 11:1; Isaiah 52:1; Daniel 9:24, which, incidentally, refers to the destruction of Jerusalem compare Daniel 9:27 + Matthew 24:15; Matthew 27:53)
- 4. What 3 time designations are used interchangeably in this chapter?
 - a. According to secular historical accounts, approximately how long did the siege and destruction of Jerusalem last?
- 5. What was the job of the two witnesses?
 - a. Related to question 5, what else were these witnesses called?
 - b. What powers were these two witnesses granted?
 - c. What happened to the two witnesses after 3 1/2 years?

- d. Following the deaths of the 2 witnesses, what common courtesy did the people refuse them when they died?
- e. How did the people react upon the deaths of the two witnesses? Why?
- 6. What did God do for these two prophets / witnesses after the 3 1/2 days?
- 7. Verse 8 speaks of a city that was symbolically called "Sodom" and "Egypt." What city was this? For help see (Jer. 23:14; Ezek. 16: 46-52; Isa. 1:10; Note: Galatians 4:25 speaks of the "Jerusalem that now is" as being "in bondage with her children." "Egypt" was the place of the Jews' original bondage)
- 8. What announcement was made when the seventh angel blew his trumpet?
- 9. What group is again mentioned in verse 16 and what did they again do?
- 10. Verse 18 reminds us of language from Psalm 2 and Isaiah 34. What is the point of Revelation 11:18?
- 11. What was seen in God's temple in Heaven?
- 12. What weather events occurred? What do these things represent?
