

Revelation 22

1. What “river” flowed from the throne of God and of the Lamb and through the middle of the city street?

2. What special “tree” is in the city?
 - a. What was the history of this tree? (see Gen. 2:9; 3:22 for help)

 - b. How did mankind lose access to this tree?

 - c. What is peculiar about the tree’s fruit and leaves?

 - d. According to verses 7, 9 and 14, what did the people have to do in order to gain (regain) access to the tree of life?

3. According to verses 3 and 15, who *will not* occupy the holy city?

4. As we saw with the people of 3:12 and 14:1, what was written on the foreheads of the city’s occupants?

5. As we have repeatedly seen, certain national judgments are addressed in this book — particularly Jewish and Roman. What do verses 6, 7, 10, 12 and 20 teach about time and the coming of Christ? (at least the sense in which Christ was “coming” according to some of this book)
 - a. Of course, we must be careful about assigning our own definitions of “time.” What does 2 Peter 3:8 teach about God’s view of “time?”

6. As also recorded in 19:10, what did John again attempt to do with regard to the angel?
 - a. What was the angel's response?
7. What was John NOT to do with the words of the prophecy of this book, and why not?
8. Thinking of verse 16: How could Christ have been both the "root" and the "offspring" of David?
9. What warning is given in verse 18?
10. What warning is given in verse 19?
11. What other Bible passage or passages issue this warning?
