- 1. Paul continues his discussion from chapter 7. What 2 times or conditions are contrasted by the word "now" in 8:1?
- 2. What 2 "laws" are contrasted in verse 2?
- 3. The phrase in verse 3, "on account of sin," or "for sin" is best translated by the NASB and NIV: "as a sin offering." With this in mind, how according to this verse, did Jesus deal with sin?
- 4. What is "the righteousness" or righteous "requirement of the Law?"
- 5. Using verses 5-8, what are the consequences of being carnally minded?
- 6. According to Romans 8:10-16, 2 Corinthians 6:18; 1 John 3:24 & 4:4, what persons of God dwell in the Christian?
 - a. How does God "dwell" in the Christian?
 - b. How does the Spirit "lead" the Christian?
- 7. How did Paul rate present *sufferings* when contrasted with future glory?

- 8. What is the "creation" of verses 19-22, and for what does it "wait?"
- 9. What did it mean for some to "have the first fruits of the Spirit?"
- 10. What observations did Paul make about "hope," which help define it?
- 11. Different views are held as to the identity of the "Spirit" or "spirit" in Romans 8:26: What arguments can be made for or against it being the human spirit rather than the Holy Spirit?
 - a. Who acts as intercessor for saints (Romans 8:34; Heb. 7:25; 1 Jn. 2:1)?
 - b. Who searches and knows the thoughts (Rev. 2:23)?
- 12. According to verse 28, what did God "predestinate?"
- 13. How do we know that God is "for us?" (see list in 32-34)
- 14. What things cannot separate us from the love of Christ?
