 - c. Who did her sons marry and what was their ethnicity?
- 4. This story contains many basic relationship lessons but also holds a significant place in the scheme of redemption:
 - a. According to Ruth 4:17, who was born to Ruth and Boaz and who was her great grandson?
 - b. According to Matthew 1:5 & 16, Who was Ruth the ancestor of?
- 5. Over a span of "about" 10 years, who all died according to verses 3-5?
- 6. What then did Naomi hear about the famine situation in Judah?

- 7. Initially, who intended to go to Judah with Naomi?
