 - a. Why did he cite the example of a soldier? (2 or 3 reasons)
 - b. Why the athlete?
 - c. Why the farmer?
- 3. Why was Paul suffering at the time of his writing this epistle? (vs. 8-9)
 - a. How was Paul suffering at that time? (9)
 - b. According to chap. 4:6-8, how much time did he think he had to live?
- 4. In the context of verses 10-12, in what sense is it so that if we "die with Christ" we shall also "live with Him.?"
- 5. What does God remain even if one of His children becomes faithless? (13)
- 6. As in 1 Timothy 1:4; 4:7 and 6:3-5, what does Paul warn against in verses 14, 16 and 23 of this chapter?

- 7. What command is given in verse 15 and why are we to do it?
- 8. What false teachers are named in this chapter? (17)
 - a. What did they teach, and what were the consequences?
- 9. In verses 19-21, what metaphor does Paul use of the church?
 - a. How are individuals represented in relation to this metaphor?
 - b. What two general categories describe people in this text?
 - c. What specific materials make up each category?

- d. In what way does verse 21 teach one's personal responsibility in being a productive part of this house (church)?
- 10. What does verse 22 suggest about Timothy's age?
- 11. According to verse 24, what is one NOT to do when teaching others?
- 12. Who grants repentance when someone is converted from his error?
- 13. What analogy is used in verse 26 to describe what the devil does to sinners?
