 - c. How many of the 10 commandments were "negative?" (Exo. 20)

- 5. What things had Paul done that gave him confidence that he would receive the crown of righteousness? (7-8)
- 6. How had Demas changed from the time of Colossians 4:14 to the time of this present writing?
- 7. From this chapter's narrative, give a brief description of the following individuals:
 - a. Luke
 - b. Mark
 - c. Tychicus
 - d. Alexander
 - e. Priscilla, Aquila, and the household of Onesiphorus
 - f. Erastus
 - g. Trophimus
 - h. Eubulus, Pudens, Linus and Claudia
- 8. What items did Paul want brought to him from Troas?
- 9. What was Paul's attitude towards those who abandoned him?
- 10. How is the word "kingdom" used in verse 18?
