

Ephesians 4

- 1) In what sense was Paul a “prisoner?”
- 2) What should characterize the Christian’s walk? (*verses 2-3 for help*)
- 3) Verses 4-6 contain what some call “the platform of unity.” What seven items are listed by Paul?
- 4) Christ gave “gifts” to men upon His ascension (v. 8). What gifts did He give according to verse 11?
 - a) What was the purpose of these gifts? (vs. 12-13)
- 5) Verses 12-16 are important in defining the work of the church: What works are here assigned to the church?

(Note: See Acts 6:1&4 for an explanation of what all is involved in the work of the “ministry.”)
- 6) How do we know that the “body” of Ephesians 4:12-16 is the *local* church and not the universal church?
- 7) What things generally characterized the gentiles in the past according to verses 17-19?
- 8) According to verses 20 and 21, what is required in order for one to put off the old self and put on the new self?
