- 2. What was Paul (Saul) doing when he was called to be an apostle? (Acts 9:1-5)
- 3. For what purpose was Paul called to be an apostle? (v. 5)
- 4. How was Jesus "declared" to be the Son of God? (4)
- 5. Verse 7 says that Paul wrote to "saints." What is a "saint?"
- 6. For what did Paul pray with respect to the Roman saints? (10-11)
 - a. What did Paul want to do for the saints at Rome?
 - b. Who all would be benefited by Paul's visit? (12)
- 7. In what sense was Paul a "debtor" or "under obligation" (v.14) to the saints at Rome?
- 8. Of what was Paul not ashamed? (16)
- 9. In verse 17, the word "faith" is used in two different ways: What is the first "faith" and what is the second "faith?"
- 10. What two types of divine revelation are discussed in verses 16 and 20?
 - a. What Psalm also addresses these two areas?

- 11. Romans chapters 1, 2 and 3 address different ethnic groups of sinners:
 - a. Which group is addressed in verses 18-32 of this chapter?
